Please ensure you are on time as we have scheduled interviews 20 minutes apart and need to stay on track to get through everybody. If you are delayed or

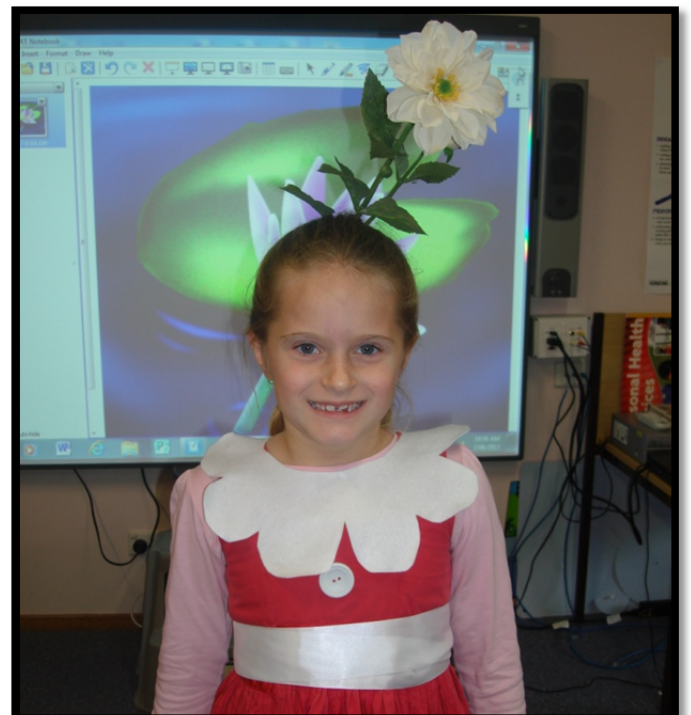
unable to attend, a phone call to the Office would be appreciated – 63422172.

Jackaroo Ranch – Winter School Holiday Horse Riding Camps

Jackaroo Ranch located at Bingletree Station at Upper Turon are running their horse riding camps in the winter vacation.

1st Week – Sat 29th June – Sat 6th July

2nd Week – Sat 6th July – Sun 14th July

Shorter stays possible if camps not fully booked.

These camps are for horse mad children aged from 6-16 yrs. 5-6 hours per day are devoted to horse activities including a one hour lesson and three hours trail riding in the beautiful Turon Valley. As well campers are taught grooming, saddler, haltering and safety aspects.

Previous experience not necessary as beginners to advanced riders are catered for.

Other activities include gold panning, cattle feeding, mustering, campfires and wildlife spotting.
